Lack of decent housing is the plight of many South Africans.

Although government has had a well-funded low-cost housing programme for years, it is marred by corruption involving public officials and in some instances elected public representatives. The allocation process of such houses is often manipulated, where applicants are often asked to pay bribes just to jump the housing queue.

Types of corruption found in the housing sector:



Procurement

Tender processes are not followed and contracts are awarded to family and friends of housing officials & Politicians.

Irregularities in the allocation of houses

Houses are allocated to specific individuals due to political connections or bribery.

Bribery

Local councillors and public officals accept bribes to speed up allocation for a house or receive a second one.

Fraud

False identities are used to obtain low-cost houses. Individuals either use the identities of deceased people or of people who are not eligible to receive an RDP house.

Unauthorised allocation of houses Local councillors sell RDP houses or allocate them to friends or family members.

Dear Corruption Watch. I am a concerned citizen from Libode in the Eastern Cape, An official in the Nyandeni Local Municipality sold two drivers licenses for R4000 each to young, unqualified drivers who did not even take the driving test. The official charges R2000 for individuals to obtain a learners' license and R4000 to get a drivers' license. The official takes the drivers' test on behalf of the applicants once the payment has been made.
