## Corruption increases the risk of unsafe conditions on our roads.

It makes our transport systems unreliable. Some of the ways in which this happens is when corrupt officials give licenses to unqualified drivers and un-roadworthy vehicles - which has potentially dangerous consequences for all road users.



# Types of corruption found on our roads:

### Bribery to avoid a traffic fine/arrest

Road users have committed an offence such as speeding. overloading or driving an unlicensed / un-roadworthy vehicle.

### **Bribery to obtain** certification

Certificates of roadworthiness are issued without vehicles being properly inspected or in cases where faults are found.

#### **Bribery to** avoid arrest

Road users have committed a chargeable offence such as driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs.

#### Threats of violence

Traffic officers demanding/are offered bribes or sexual favours or else threats of physically harm are made.

### **Bribery to obtain** a driver's license

Applicants pay bribes to licensing officials to obtain a learner's or driver's license.

#### Abuse of power

Road users are detained for up to a period of 48 hours without any formal charges laid against the individual, if they refuse to pay a bribe.
