Corruption is a serious threat to all of us who rely on public hospitals and clinics.

Not only does it make it difficult for us to get proper treatment when we are vulnerable and cannot pay a bribe, but when funds, medicines and equipment are stolen or misused by officials, it is a setback for the whole community.

Types of corruption found in our health care:

Informal payments

Unofficial payments given to healthcare providers at more than the official cost or for services that are supposed to be free.

Bribes

Money or something of value promised or given in exchange for an official action.

Inappropriate healthcare facility certification

Unwarranted certification is provided to a healthcare facility due to personal or political connections or the receipt of a bribe.

Inappropriate healthcare training facility certification

Unwarranted certification is provided to a healthcare facility due to personal or political connections or the receipt of a bribe.

Selling of government posts

Demanding payment from government agents to secure or keep their positions.

Fraud

Includes false invoicing, 'ghost' patients or services, and diversion of funds into private bank accounts.

Theft / misuse of property

Theft or unlawful use of property such as medicines, equipment, cars for personal use, for use in a private medical practice, resale or renting.

Embezzlement of funds

National funds allocated for healthcare services are stolen or deliberately diverted.

Moonlighting

Healthcare professionals abusing leave policies or conducting their private practice during work hours.

Nepotism

Employment opportunities are given to friends and family.

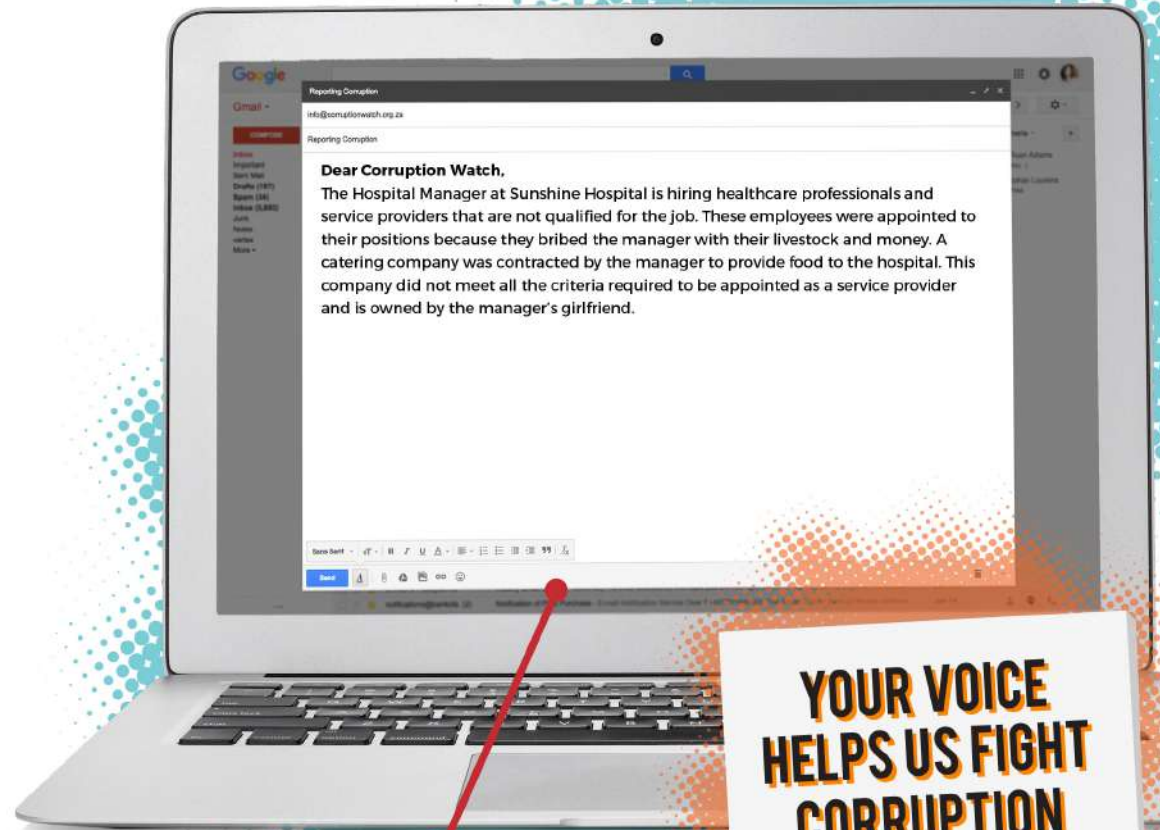
Improper healthcare accreditation

Approve a healthcare professional's qualifications due to personal or political connections or a bribe.

Procurement corruption

Includes bribes, kickbacks, fraudulent invoicing, collusion among suppliers, failure to audit performance on contracts, etc.
