Zondo Commission – proceedings halted until January 2019

The commission of inquiry into state capture announced on Tuesday that it had halted its public hearings until January. The date of the recommencement of the hearings, chaired by Deputy Chief Justice Raymond Zondo, will be announced next month.

According to the commission's Twitter feed, the reason for the postponement is that although some witnesses were ready to be heard over the next couple of weeks, they have opted for supplementing their evidence with new information that they would have otherwise left out.

Corruption Watch continues to support the work of the commission and will resume the service of providing regular updates on the proceedings once the hearings have started again.
