IN RE: VENETE KLEIN // CORRUPTION WATCH

- 1. We represent Ms Venete Klein.
- 2. An extract from the Business Day, dated 20 March 2019, is attached hereto ("the publication").
- 3. The publication is designed to vilify and humiliate Ms Klein; it depicts her as a criminal and contains language that can reasonably be interpreted as a call to arms "wipe the smiles of these faces" and "remove these delinquents from public life".
- 4. Ms Klein is not a "delinquent". To say that she is, is defamatory and factually incorrect.
- 5. In the most distasteful way, Corruption Watch seeks to raise funds on the back of the defamatory content of the publication.
- 6. The publication creates risks for Ms Klein's personal security, by irresponsibly and without foundation drawing a link between the current electricity crisis and Ms Klein. After the publication, Ms Klein has experienced public hostility which could well be a precursor to physical attacks on her and her property.
- 7. The publication, furthermore, has a direct and adverse effect on Ms Klein's dignity and reputation and her current and future business opportunities.

- 8. Ms Klein is furthermore, as Corruption Watch is well aware, opposing the delinquency application brought by Corruption Watch. It is highly inappropriate for Corruption Watch to seek to pre-empt the outcome of litigation in which it is a party, by making the very claims which a court is yet to decide.
- 9. As you are aware, Ms Klein has also made extensive submissions to Parliament which demonstrates her innocence.
- 10. In the circumstances, Ms Klein demands the following:
 - 10.1. a written apology; and
 - 10.2. an undertaking that Corruption Watch will not in future publish, or cause to be published, the same publication, or a similar publication in respect of Ms Klein in the Business Day or any other similar platform, publication or media.
- 11. Ms Klein's rights to damages, including special damages, remain reserved.
- 12. We look forward to hearing form you as soon as possible, and in any event by the close of business on Tuesday, 26 March 2019.
- 13. We are aware that Corruption Watch is legally represented in the delinquency application and we have, accordingly, copied the attorneys in that matter in this letter.
- 14. Kindly acknowledge receipt of this letter.
