Ms Kalidass was appointed as a member of the SABC Board in 2013. In 2015, she was removed by her fellow board members, allegedly for opposing the appointment of Hlaudi Motsoeneng as Chief Operating Officer. Her removal was declared as unlawful following the receipt of a legal opinion from Parliament's legal service, requested by the Portfolio Committee on Communication. Ms Kalidass
